The Audubon Conservation Education Center presents the **Heritage Walkway** brick project to recognize community contributions to the development of youth education programs and site infrastructure improvements. Your custom brick will be engraved with the name of your family, loved one, business, or organization, and will become a permanent part of the Center's rich heritage. The walkway will guide visiting students and families to the entrance of the new facility at the Center—*The Norm Schoenthal Wet Lab*. The lab is surrounded with beautifully landscaped habitat gardens demonstrating native plants, wise water use, and xeriscape techniques. The gardens are an inviting setting for educational programs and workshops, and also provide habitat for birds and butterflies.

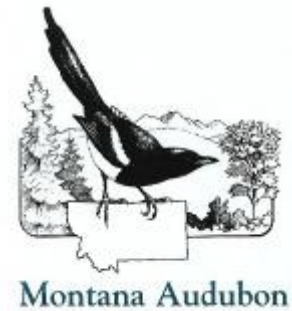

The Audubon Conservation Education Center exists through strong community partnerships initiated by Yellowstone River Parks Association, Montana Audubon, and Yellowstone Valley Audubon. The Center, situated in an ideal location along the banks of the Yellowstone River and adjacent to Riverfront Park West, provides a restored habitat for wildlife preservation and human exploration. The Heritage Walkway will be the focal point of the entrance to the Norm Schoenthal Wet Lab. Each year, thousands of Billings area youth and adults will walk this path as they enter the Center to explore nature, conduct hands-on science, and create fun! Here, you are likely to see youth and volunteers down on the ground planting trees, or in the water scooping up aquatic insects into nets—a place to get dirty, muddy, and close to nature. Here, people of all ages, from Billings and surrounding areas can gain a sense of the wild home they live in and share with birds and animals, anchored by the Yellowstone River ecosystem. Help us educate youth and the community about the importance of this unique and wonderful ecosystem.

Your support will help us accomplish the following:

- ⇒ Engage youth from Kindergarten through University in year round environmental science programs.
- ⇒ Create opportunities for family outdoor recreation, wildlife watching, and nature education programs.
- ⇒ Construct the Norm Schoenthal Wet Lab for school programs and community workshops.
- ⇒ Restore 27-acres of wildlife habitat
- ⇒ Create interpretive trail and information kiosks.
